An essential item for music therapists and music teachers, the songs and related activities cover many areas special learners may focus on -- basic grooming, fine/gross motor skills, and social skills. The songs vary greatly in both tempo and style; the words are very easy to understand. The authors give suggestions on how to adapt each activity to children with different physical challenges.
